To summarise main points from the meeting:

- Please ensure your child has all their medication with them. Ghyll Head staff are qualified first aiders. Please return the medication / permission form to Miss McCoy as soon as possible.
- Please do not bring money or snacks. Food will be provided by Ghyll Head. If you have a dietary requirement (kosher/halal/vegetarian etc.) please ensure this is completed on the form.
- Activities are lead in small groups by qualified instructors. The activities that take place will be weather permitting and safety comes first.
- Children will be encouraged to achieve and challenge themselves in a caring and supportive manner.
- Pupils should not bring electronic devices or phones.
- Kit lists have been given out, please use old clothing. Ghyll Head provide all the correct safety equipment.
- St Hilda's will be the only school at the centre during our stay.
- Bedrooms for boys and girls are on separate sides of the building and St Hilda's staff will be in the same building. I will organise rooms to ensure that children are with at least 1 of their friends in their bedrooms.
