Year 5 Adopt a Halle Musician Project

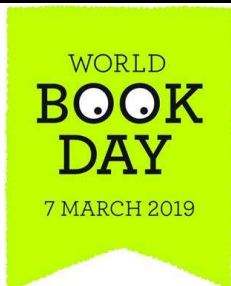

World Book Day Friday 8th March.



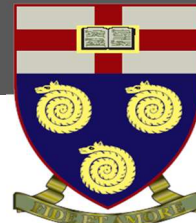
