

## St Hilda's CE Primary School Results for the academic year 2017/2018

### Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

EYFS	There were 30 pupils in the EYFS cohort, 90% of pupils met the expected standard (GLD –Good Level of Development) at the end of EYFS. 100% of Pupil Premium pupils met their GLD. This is well above the national figure (72%) and Trafford (75.3%).
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### Key Stage 1 Phonics

Key Stage 1 Phonics	There were 48 pupils in this cohort. 87% of pupils passed the Y1 phonics screening test. This is 3% higher than Trafford (86%) and 4% higher than national figure (83%). 100% of the 16 Y2 pupils who resat the phonics test passed.

Key Stage 1 Reading, Writing & Maths Combined	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The combined percentage for pupils meeting the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics was 69%. This is 4% higher than the national figure of 65%.</li> </ul>
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Year 2 Reading Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 81 % of pupils met the expected standard or above at the end of Key Stage 1. This was 6% above the national figure of 75% and 3% above Trafford at 78%.</li> <li>➤ 29% of pupils achieved the higher standard. This was 1% lower than Trafford (30%) and 3% higher than the national average at 26%.</li> </ul>
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Year 2 Writing Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 75% of pupils met the expected standard or above at the end of Key Stage 1. This was 5% above the national figure of 70% and 3% above Trafford (72%).</li> <li>➤ 19% of pupils achieved the higher standard. This was 2% higher than Trafford (17%) and 3% higher than the national average at 16%.</li> </ul>
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Year 2 Mathematics Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 85 % of pupils met the expected standard or above at the end of Key Stage 1. This was 9% above the national figure of 76% and 5% above Trafford at 80%.</li> <li>➤ 27% of pupils achieved the higher standard. This was 2% higher than Trafford (27%) and 5% higher than the national average at 22%.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ There were 44 pupils in this cohort. 43 pupils completed the SATs.</li> <li>➤ The combined percentage for pupils meeting the expected standard in reading, writing and maths was 55 %. This was 9% lower than the national figure of 64%.</li> <li>➤ The combined percentage for pupils achieving the higher standard/greater depth standard in reading, writing and maths combined was 5% which was 5% lower than the national figure of 10%.</li> </ul>			
Key Stage 2 Reading Progress and Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The progress measure for reading was -1.3.</li> <li>➤ 75% of pupils met the expected standard or above in reading at the end of Key Stage 2 which is in line with the national figure.</li> <li>➤ 25% of pupils met the higher standard in reading at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 3% below the national average of 28%.</li> <li>➤ The average scaled score for reading was 105 which is in line with the national figure and 2 lower than Trafford at 107.</li> </ul>			
Key Stage 2 Writing Progress & Attainment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The progress measure for writing was -2.6.</li> <li>➤ 73 % of pupils met the expected standard or above in writing at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 5% lower than the national average of 78%.</li> <li>➤ 11% of pupils met the higher standard in writing at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 9% lower than the national average at 20%.</li> </ul>			
Key Stage 2 Mathematics Progress & Assessment Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The progress measure for mathematics was -1.7</li> <li>➤ 64% of pupils met the expected standard or above in mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 12% lower than the national average.</li> <li>➤ 30% of pupils met the higher standard in mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2. This was 6% higher than the national average.</li> <li>➤ The average scaled score for mathematics was 104 which is in line with the national figure and 3 lower than Trafford at 107.</li> </ul>
