Track and Trace Testing

From **Wednesday 1st July - Friday 3rd July** a Mobile Testing Unit will operate at the car park of University Academy 92 (UA92) in Stretford. This is the car park opposite the cricket ground on Brian Statham Way.

This will allow anyone who has Covid symptoms to get tested without having to travel as far as they normally would have to. Symptoms include at least one of the following symptoms: a new cough, a high temperature, or a loss/change in your taste/smell.

Booking is available through the national booking site for these dates either online ([click here](#)) or by calling 119. The slots at UA92 will become live at 6pm the day before (Tuesday 30th June).

Children aged 2 and above are able to book a test. The site is a self-swabbing one, which means parents/carers will need to swab their child.

Please note that the site will not be able to test anyone who has not booked a place and they will not be able to access the site. A limited number of slots will be available to walk in to the site, but this should only be used if you don't have access to a car (you still need to have booked).

Summer provision

Unfortunately, BOSH is unable to open over the summer holidays and the school will now be closed due to rewiring works. Trafford Council will be arranging childcare provision options over the summer in schools and local community buildings across the borough. St Hilda's will communicate this as soon as we are informed by the Local Authority regarding their provision offer.

St Hilda's Provision

It has been wonderful to be able to invite more children back to school. Children have settled into their new routines well and have thoroughly enjoyed their learning. We will communicate the school's position regarding our September provision once new guidance is released. St Hilda's is working with Vantage Trust to devise a recovery curriculum and support our children academically, socially and emotionally on their return. Mrs Beaumont, our pastoral lead, will continue to work closely with children who need additional emotional support.

Home Learning and Support

Staff are continuing to conduct welfare calls as well as set up Zoom meetings. Please follow the class blogs for Zoom invites. If you need any support, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher via Seesaw or contact the office to request a call back.

Assemblies will continue to run each week. It was lovely to see how many people joined and was great to get children involved in the life of school from home. Teachers will also be setting challenges on the class Seesaw pages, so please share your responses on the blogs. Children will also be able to attend Zoom calls with their class to speak to their friends; these will run weekly. We encourage children to post and share their learning where possible with their teachers and classmates via Seesaw.

The government recommended Oak Academy is still available online as well as BBC Bitesize to support families with home learning. Weekly home learning planning will continue to be provided until the end of the Summer term.
