## INTRODUCTION

### 1.1

At St Hilda's Primary School, we have high expectations of our pupils and their uniform. Outsiders often judge a school by the appearance of its pupils in public. Wearing a uniform encourages a feeling of security and gives a sense of belonging to a community.

## LABELING OF SCHOOL UNIFORM

### 2.1

All individual parts of the school uniform must be labelled with your child's name and their year group.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM- RECEPTION TO YEAR 6

### 3.1 Pupils are expected to wear the following school uniform:

- Blue jumper or cardigan (with or without the school crest).
- Grey trousers.
- Grey skirt/ pinafore dress.
- Grey or white socks.
- Grey tights.
- Reception to Year 5: white polo shirt – tucked in.
- Year 6: white-collar shirt.
- Year 6: tie – this is provided by the school in September.
- Black school shoes- no trainers.
- Blue gingham summer dress (summer term).
- Coat/ raincoat

## PE KIT- YEAR 1 TO YEAR 6

### 4.1

Children are expected to bring their PE kit to school on their allocated PE day/days. The day/days will be shared with families in September. If PE kits are needed for any other reason, families will be informed via the class dojo.

### **Pupils are expected to wear the following PE kit:**

- Plain black shorts.
- Black leggings or tracksuit bottoms- no logos.
- Plain white t-shirt.
- Trainers.
- PE in the hall will be done in bare feet or children can bring a pair of black pumps.

Children are not to come in branded clothing or football kits etc.

Pupils who do not bring their PE kit will still be expected to participate in lessons. A spare PE kit will be given to wear. Children will be sent home with a letter for parents informing them to bring their PE kit.

## **ACCESSORIES**

### 5.1 Hair Accessories

- All hair accessories should be blue/black and be discreet.

### 5.2 Jewellery

- Jewellery
- Earrings – one small plain pair of studs, of a maximum diameter of 3mm, can be worn in the ear lobe.
- No other piercings are allowed.
- Jewellery worn for religious observance is permissible.
- All jewellery will be removed for PE lessons to ensure students are safe.

### 5.3 Make-Up and Nail-Polish

- Make-up and nail varnish is not to be worn in school and children wearing it will be asked to remove it. Fake tattoos are not appropriate at school and must be removed before returning to school.
